Sports Day – Thursday 22nd June – 1.30-3.30pm

Sports Day will take place on Thursday 22nd June at 1.30 p.m. at the Cricket Field, weather permitting. We will walk across with the children after lunch. We will then have our races and tea. Children will be taken home by parents from the cricket field, walk home if you have given your written permission or collected from the ground at 3.30 p.m. Please ensure that you are clear in your arrangements on the consent form and that your child is aware of these arrangements. No child will be allowed to leave by themselves at 3.30 p.m. unless we have written permission on the form. If your child is being collected by relatives, taxi or other means eg Sunflowers or childminder, please ensure that they are aware of the finish time and location (Glasshouses Cricket Field).

All children need their P.E. kit in school on this day and a hat as there is very little shade at the field. Please ensure that your child has sun cream etc applied in the morning if the weather is warm and suitable warm and waterproof clothing if it is looking like rain. Could you also send in a drink for your child to take across, a drinks bottle with water would be ideal so they can have several drinks as required.

Could I please ask that parents send in donations of food to enable our children to enjoy a picnic tea after their races. The children will finish their races then line up outside the cricket pavilion where the PTA set out a lovely tea for the children to choose from. If the weather is good they enjoy their picnic on the grass. If the weather is bad the children will squeeze into the pavilion! The PTFA are requesting offers of help on the day to serve the tea. Please try to sign up to make this a successful day for all.
