GLASSHOUSES COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL

Children are admitted in school in the academic year after their 4th birthday

Children will be admitted on a part time basis (each morning) for the first week of the September term to allow settling in.

Children may then attend full time. Parents may request that their child continues to attend part time (each morning) until their child reaches compulsory school age

Parents can request that their child's admittance is deferred until in the school year or until the child reaches compulsory school age. The place can be held for the child until the beginning of the term after the child's 5th birthday. Entry may not be deferred beyond the child's academic year for which the original application was accepted. Application may also be made for entry to school to be postponed by a year e.g. if your child is a summer born child with additional needs. Please have a word with us should you feel this would be of benefit to your child.

Our current admission number is 10. Admission Policy is set by NYCC and may be obtained from Local Area Education Office, Ainsty Road, Harrogate.

Please register your interest as early as possible but be aware that the decision regarding allocation of places is made by N.Y.C.C. School will then send you a Parents Information Pack which must be returned to Area Education Office, Ainsty Road, Harrogate. Allocation of places is confirmed to school and parents in May. You will then be invited to a familiarisation meeting when details of uniform/daily routines/necessary preparation and what will happen during your child's first year at school will be passed on to you.

If your child is currently attending school elsewhere, we will be happy to arrange induction visits to enable you and your child to see our facilities and meet pupils and staff.
