In maths we have had a division week learning the bus shelter method for divide. This has been a tricky week this week but the children have challenged themselves and kept going.



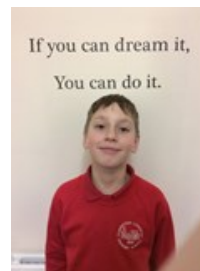
News from Working Wolves
