



Preventative measures

Information sharing with parents and children

Increased frequency and duration of handwashing

Events where children come into significant contact with others to be cancelled

Reduce the number of visitors to school by only allowing essential visits

Managing staff absence

Stage 1 – school open as normal

Stage 2 – some staff are absent but this is managed in school. Classes and the structure of the school day may be different

Stage 3 - school is open, but providing childcare /supervision only.

Stage 4 – school is closed
